Purpose and legal basis

To fulfill our contract with you or to carry out pre-contractual measures in accordance with Art. 6 (1)(b) GDPR, we process your data for the purpose of sending offers, for billing and order processing. For our legitimate interest in informing you about our company portfolio and product cues, the processing of your data is necessary based on Art. 6 (1)(f) GDPR. For our legitimate interest in processing your data as a contact person for your company, we also refer to Art. 6 (1)(f) GDPR.

Recipients of your data

Within our company, access to your data will be restricted to authorized bodies necessary to fulfill our processing purposes. Your data will not be forwarded to third parties.

Storage period of your data

We store your personal data for the duration of our business relationships and beyond only for as long as we are required by law.

Your rights

In accordance with Art. 15 GDPR, you have the right to obtain access to the data stored about you. If inaccurate or incomplete personal data has been processed, you have a right to rectification in accordance with Art. 16 GDPR.

If the legal requirements are met, you can request that the processing be erased or restricted and you can object to the data processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR). According to Art. 20 GDPR, you can claim the right to data portability for data that is processed automatically on the basis of your consent or a contract with you.

These rights can be asserted against GLI Business Solutions GmbH at the address given above under the heading „Identity and contact details of the controller“.

If you believe that data processing violates data protection law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority.
